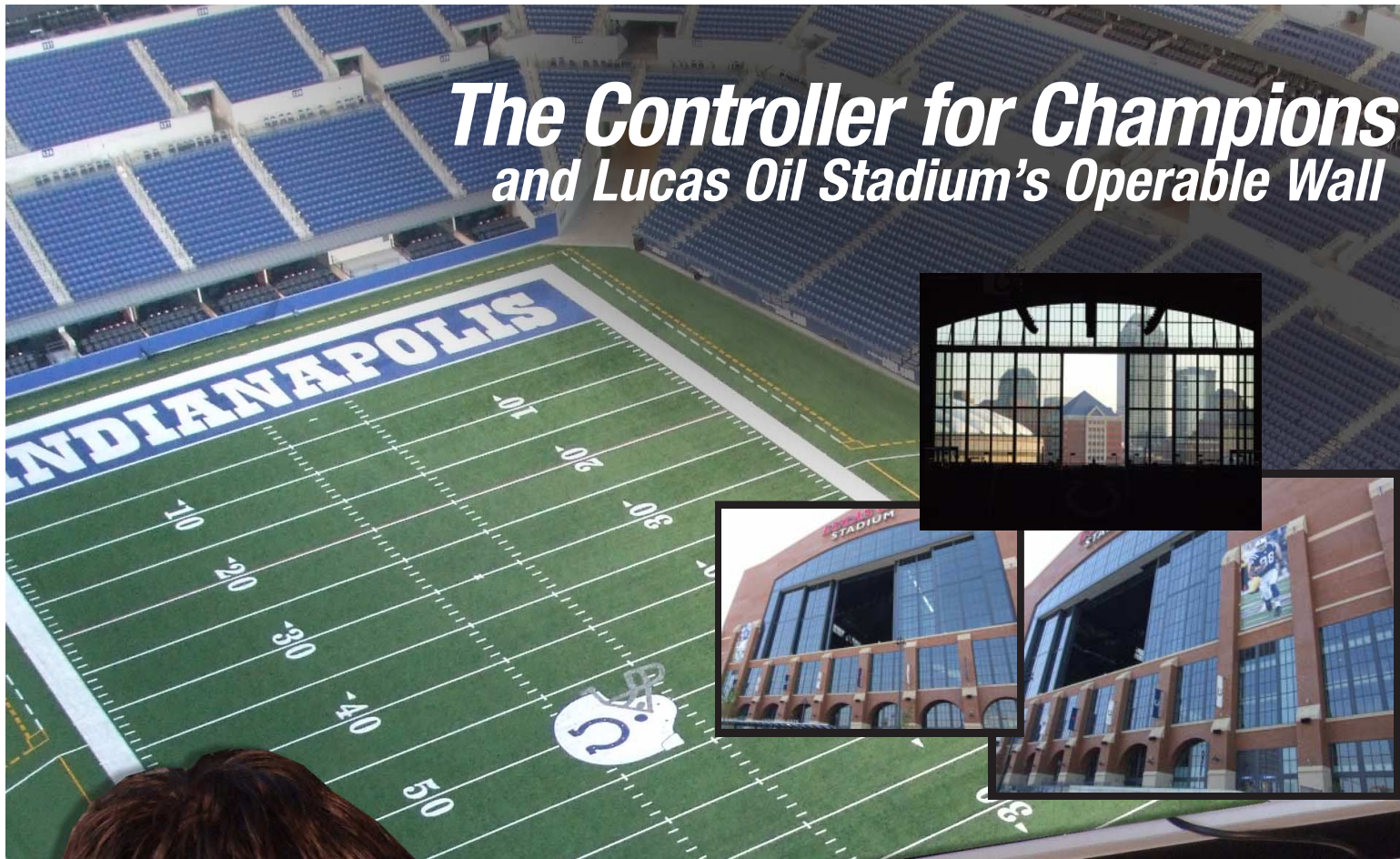


# The Controller for Champions and Lucas Oil Stadium's Operable Wall



When the architects and engineers at Uni-Systems of Minneapolis, MN selected a system to control the operable wall within the new Lucas Oil Stadium, they chose Horner APG's Operator Control Station.

Uni-Systems selected Horner's QX451 Operator Control Station to control the opening and closing of the *operable wall*, a mammoth 88 foot tall, six-paneled glass window pane that exposes a panoramic view of the city of Indianapolis to all inside Lucas Oil Stadium.
